TEMCOR TO COVER WATER RESERVOIRS AT CAMP PENDLETON

GARDENA, CA, August 24, 2001 — The U.S. Marine Corps has awarded Temcor a contract to cover potable water reservoirs at its Camp Pendleton, California Marine base. Four existing reservoirs will be covered with Temcor's all-aluminum strut and panel cover systems. This is the company's fifth project at the base. In 1987, Temcor built a 93' square roof over another reservoir on the base, which was followed by another eight roofs in subsequent years. Temcor is the world's largest Aluminum Dome builder.

"The covers being replaced are steel-framed V-Beam roofs that are rusting," said Bob Kurtz, Temcor's national sales manager for industrial and municipal products. "The corrosion-resistant properties that are inherent in Temcor's all-aluminum construction will give them a much longer life-span than steel alternatives."

Temcor won the contract after a competitive bid process. The covers are scheduled to be complete this October.

The reservoir covers specified in the contract are all low-rise, column-supported roofs using Temcor's unique strut and panel system. Temcor will build one cover each in the following sizes: 163' x 305'; 139' x 231'; 105' x 143' and 57' x 118'. Each of the roofs will be supported by stainless steel columns and will have accessories such as access hatches, gravity vents, insect screens, walkways and tank gauges as required.

Temcor has been building aluminum domes and other structures for more than 35 years and has more than 6,000 installations throughout the world in industries as varied as water and wastewater treatment, petroleum and scientific research. Temcor domes and roof systems for architectural applications are in place as sports arenas, cruise terminals, planetariums, churches, and more.
