415' diameter TEMCOR Aluminum Dome

USE: Exhibit Hall for Spruce Goose and Howard Hughes Memorabilia from 1982 to 1992
Currently in use as a sound studio for movie production.

DESCRIPTION: The world's largest clear-span aluminum dome houses more than 135,000 square feet of permanent and temporary exhibit space as well as a special events center which can accommodate up to 3,500 people. The Temcor Aluminum Dome rises 130' above grade from a steel wide flange beam embedded in concrete.

The exterior is covered in maintenance-free fluoropolymer paint and the interior is finished in dark thermal/acoustic fiberglass insulation.
